Phase 2

Instructions For Those Who Plan To Attend Our In-Person Worship Gathering During Phase 2:

1. When you arrive, park in the main parking lot between the church buildings and Treyton Oak Towers. Please understand that entering the sanctuary will look much different than the last time you attended a few months ago. We have several teams in place to help you navigate from the parking lot to your designated row in the worship center.
2. From the main parking lot, you will enter the building through the “Welcome Center Entrance.” You will notice orange tape on the concrete outside the Welcome Center Doors. This tape signifies the social distancing guidelines which recommend at least six feet of space between people while waiting for entrance into the building. For those who need to use the elevator, it will be available. One family will ride at a time while a Team Member from the church operates the elevator.
3. You must wear a face covering that fully covers your nose and mouth while waiting to enter the building, when exiting the building, and when moving about the building. When you are seated in your designated row for the worship service, masks will be optional. You may remove your mask if you wish during the service. If you have your own face covering, please bring it and wear it as you approach the building. We have a limited supply of face coverings available if you do not have your own, but cannot guarantee one for all who wish to attend.
4. Once inside the building at the Welcome Center doors, your temperature will be taken by one of our Health Ministry Team members. If your temperature is below 100.5, you will be able to enter the sanctuary.
5. Once your temperature has been taken, and you have a face covering, you will be directed into the sanctuary by one of our Compliance Team members. They will assign you a seat in the sanctuary. Compliance Team members will be wearing bright colored vests so that you can clearly identify them.
6. Once you are in your designated seat in the sanctuary, please remain in that spot for the remainder of the service. Bathrooms will be available, but on a one person at a time basis and they will be cleaned by one of our Cleaning Team members after each use. Offering baskets will be placed at entrance/exit doors of the sanctuary. You will see hand sanitizer stations throughout the facility that we encourage you to use often. Crossroads will also be closed and off limits.
7. At the end of the service, please stay seated, we will dismiss you by section. Please remember to practice social distancing and may we do our best to be good neighbors and to love one another well during this time.

Our staff is extremely excited for the opportunity to see you again in person! While this will be a different experience for all of us, we ask for your cooperation and understanding. As we gather new information from our governmental/ health officials and when we feel it is safe and feasible to enter into the next phase, we will communicate that clearly to you at the appropriate time. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
