
LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION, BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL

ORD, a wicked inclination remains in us that is bent toward backsliding. As soon as you forgive our sins, we are ready to return to our foolish ways. But if constant trials are necessary to keep us from pride, let your grace be sufficient for us. Make us strong where we are weak. Make us more than conquerors through Christ who has loved us. Make us strong in the Lord, since our struggle is not simply against flesh and blood. Reinforce us with your powerful might, since our warfare is against principalities, powers, and the rulers of the darkness of this world. As the God of peace, tread Satan under our feet, and do it soon. Keep us from falling, and present us faultless before yourself at Christ's glorious appearing. Claim us as your possession so that we are redeemed from all vices. Free us from the sin that so easily entangles us as we run the race of faith. Terrify us with your warnings to empty us of all pride of self. Banish lying from us once and for all. Remove every desire to eat the sinners' dainties. Put in our hearts the basic inclination to live according to the limitations of your laws rather than

being driven by covetousness. Restrain our lips so that we never speak rashly, as did Moses. Above all, keep your servant from presumptuous sins. Let them never dominate us.
