Read Psalm 91

Pray

Sing the two songs on the YouTube playlist

1. How is life different for you than it was two or three weeks ago? What emotions are you feeling? How is life different in our country and the world than it was two or three weeks ago? What emotions do you see others expressing?
2. Things could go on like this for several more weeks or longer, how do you feel when you think about that possibility? What do you think will be the hardest part of this?
3. Who around our community, state, nation, world are trying to do something to address all of the problems we are facing because of the virus? What kinds of things are they doing? How successful are their actions at fixing the problem?
4. How might people respond if tomorrow someone showed up with a cure for those who were sick and something to keep others from getting sick?

After you have had a chance to answer/discuss these questions play the video.

After the video spend some time answering/discussing these questions.

1. How is Jesus different from other leaders and those with power and authority? How do you see his power and authority demonstrated in this passage? How should this make a difference in our lives in the midst of the changing and uncertain times that we find ourselves in right now?
2. After the people experienced the benefits of Jesus' power and authority how did they respond? Why do you think they wanted to keep him from leaving them?
3. What are some ways we may live that show we just want to keep Jesus to ourselves? How does Jesus respond to their desires for him to stay? Why can't he stay?
4. What are some ways that we can share the good news of the kingdom of Jesus in word and deed over the next few weeks and months in the midst of the circumstances we are all facing?
5. Close with a time of prayer for us to find our hope and strength in Jesus and for us to share that hope and strength with others.
