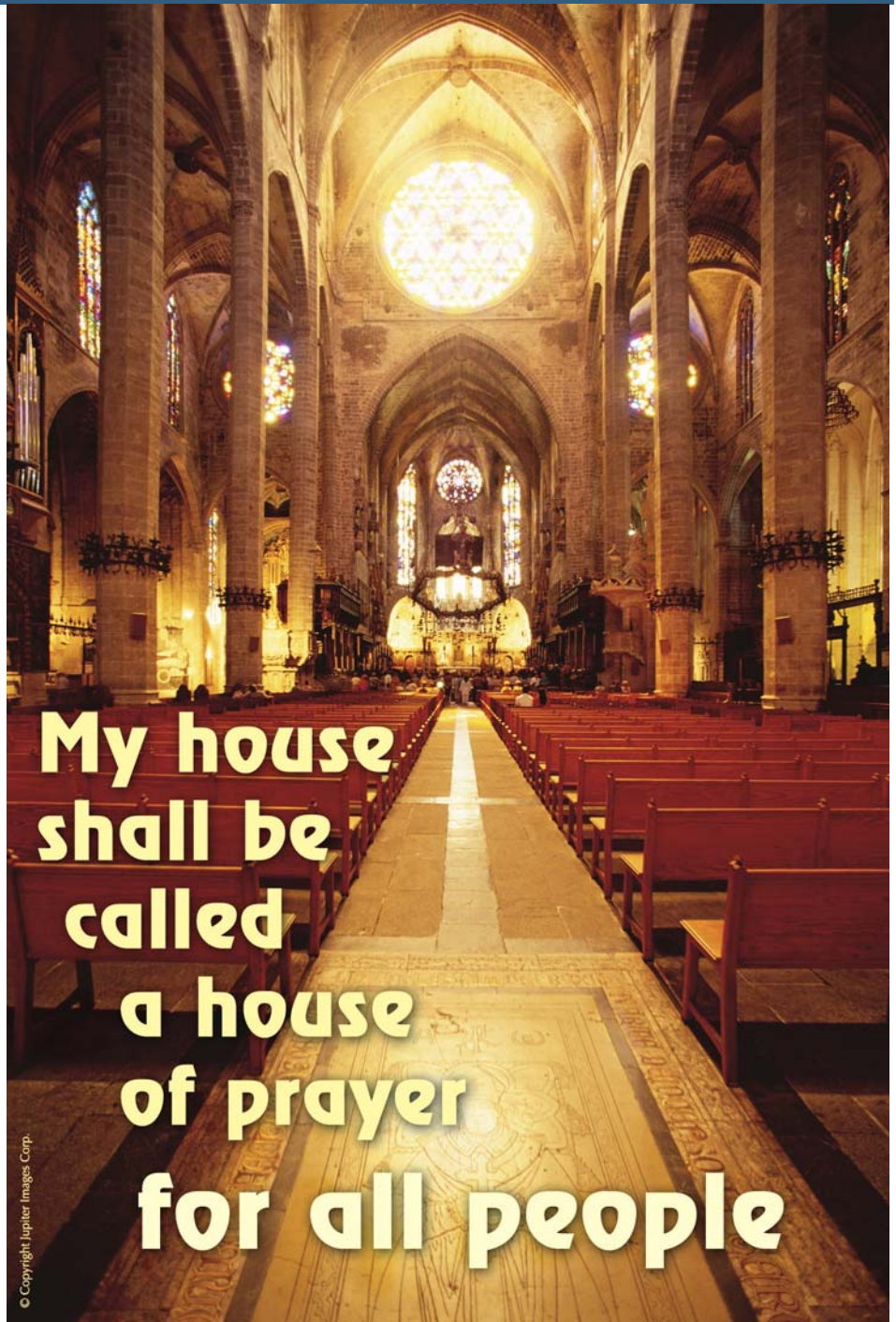

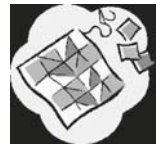

“ESSENTIAL THREE” SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS

VIRTUS Are you currently serving (or considering serving) in a ministry that serves children, youth, or vulnerable adults? If so, you are required to complete (or update) your safe environment credentials BEFORE you begin serving. Failing to do so will prevent you from serving in your ministry.

Any of the following ministries require our volunteers to complete a **background check** (paid for by St. Gabriel), complete a **Code of Conduct** training (online) and read and sign the Code of Conduct (online), along with completing training on reporting abuse (online), and attend a live **Virtus session** (Protecting God's Children for Adults) OR (if updating your

SMALL GROUP MEDITATION

**August 20, 2017, Twentieth Sunday
in Ordinary Time**



Isaiah 56:1, 6-7; Psalm 67;

Romans 11:13-15, 29-32; Matthew 15:21-28

Seeing Jesus as a teacher has been common from the very beginning of his ministry. Indeed, his title, *rabbi*, means teacher. So, it is natural to look at his actions and his words for instruction. Matthew's gospel is organized into five books, each with a narrative of Jesus' activities and then a discourse, in which Jesus specifically teaches in a sermon. The fourth book of Matthew's gospel, (chapters 14-18), revolves around Jesus' instruction of Peter and the apostles for their role as the foundation of his Church. Given this background, what is Jesus teaching the apostles, and us, in today's passage? First, let us look at his actions. John the Baptist had just been killed by Herod, so Jesus withdrew from Galilee to a place even further from Jerusalem. He fed 5000 people in the wilderness. He walked on a stormy sea to his apostles in their perilous boat. He corrected the Pharisees who criticized his disciples for not washing their hands before they ate. He healed many suffering people in another Gentile territory, just by allowing them to touch his clothes. In today's passage, he interacted with a Canaanite woman, a Gentile outside the community of Israel. It was a strange interaction; first he ignored her, then he almost insulted her by comparing her to a dog. (Dogs were stray scavengers in Israel much like we consider rodents or raccoons today.) But the lesson did not end there. His words to the Canaanite woman are full of meaning and instruction. "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you desire." (Matt 15:28) From calling her "woman" to acknowledging her great faith, Jesus taught Peter, the apostles, and is teaching us many important lessons about the way we live as the Church, both individually as members

of the body of Christ, and as his Church, his bride on earth.

Reflection Questions:

- In going to the district of Tyre and Sidon, Jesus went outside the boundaries of Jewish territory, yet he says to the Canaanite woman, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." Does this seem inconsistent to you? Read the following passages: Matthew 13:53-58; 14: 34-36; 16:13-20. Nazareth was Jesus' hometown in Galilee. Both Gennesaret and Caesarea Philippi were Gentile territories. What wisdom is Jesus teaching about who can be saved and how? How does this wisdom affect our ideas and decisions about our own Catholic Church and our parish?
- Notice the change in Jesus' tone towards the Canaanite woman in this passage. Recall that Scripture cannot contradict itself in teaching the truths about God and his plan of salvation. If that is true, why do you think Jesus started out by comparing her to a dog, and ended by calling her "woman", (read John 2:4), and praising her great faith and healing her daughter? What truth is he trying to reveal?
- No one could be in Jesus' presence and escape his teaching. What did he try to teach the apostles in this event? What lesson did he teach the Canaanite woman? What lesson is he teaching his Church? What lesson is he teaching you?
- One of the many areas in which Jesus taught the truths of his kingdom is prayer. Discuss how this passage changes your views on your own prayer. If you are comfortable, share one prayer you have been making that is not being answered. How do you deal with that? What could God be trying to teach you?

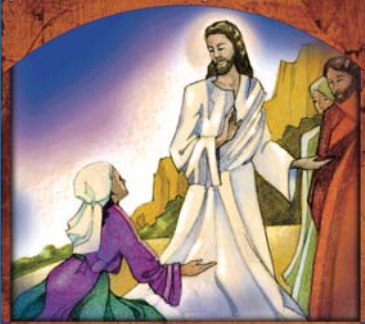
