

I have 3 thoughts to share for this newsletter. 1st, I want to begin by expressing my appreciation to all who planned and participated in DWMBC's 150th Anniversary. What a wonderful time of singing, testimonies, fellowship, and delicious food.

2nd, it hardly seems possible, but February is almost gone and soon the March winds will be bringing April showers and beautiful dogwoods, azaleas, and other flowers. Spring reminds us of "new life." I pray that you have found a new life in Jesus. If not, what are you waiting for?

3rd, I would like to share something that has been on my heart in recent days. I am convinced that we have raised up a generation in our churches that are more concerned about getting their needs met than they are with reaching not-yet-believers for Jesus. We come to church week-after-week, we meet, we sing about how good God is, we listen to preaching about Jesus who can change lives, and then we go home and do nothing. Then we come back the following week only to repeat the same cycle.

It is time to make some changes. It is time to begin to have the heartbeat of God. It has been stated on many occasions, "If we keep doing what we've always done then we will keep getting what we have always gotten." Or another way that I put it is like this: "We cannot become what we need to be by remaining what we are."

DWMBC, I want to challenge you to seriously look at and evaluate how effective you are in the community where God has strategically placed you. Then after you have evaluated, be willing to do whatever it takes to "storm the gates of hell" and reach not-yet-believers and become relevant in the lives of those in your area of influence.

Every church should make no apologies for demanding of members that it is their responsibility to love God – worship; love others – be involved in a small group Bible study for the purpose of growing in their relationship with Jesus; and love the world – no longer is it OK just to come and occupy a pew. We must be involved in some type of mission endeavor. We must be the hands, feet, ears, eyes, and mouth of Jesus.

The time is short. Will you join me? More importantly, will you join Jesus! The rewards are out of this world!
