

Santa Marta, Colombia Project

In March of 2023, a team of eight people was sent by Reformed Mission Services to Colombia to assist in installing a roof on a church plant of Calvary Iglesia Reformada located in San Juan del Cesar. During their time there, the team also had the opportunity to learn more about the work taking place closer to Calvary in Santa Marta.

The congregation at Calvary is highly active, seeking to plant churches similar to the one in San Juan. Additionally, they operate an after-school program that offers food, tutoring, and medical check-ups to local students. The church oversees all aspects of this foundation, including curriculum, staff recruitment, facility provision, and day-to-day operations. They are currently renting a facility with escalating rent expenses.

The church is working on building a third floor on their church to house the after-school program and church in one building. One major benefit of this is to eliminate the rental cost they currently have. They will also be able to utilize the third floor on Sundays for Sunday school and Catechism classes. The project requires \$12,000 in funding, with the church having already raised \$2,000 towards it. With these funds, work has begun! (see pictures below) Once completed all their work can be under one roof!
