RE-CONNECT SUNDAY REIMAGINED! – SEPTEMBER 13th!

Yes! **RE-CONNECT Sunday** is coming!!! Can you believe it?

Why RE-CONNECT Sunday? The mission of our church is **SHARING GOD'S HOPE WHEREVER WE FIND OURSELVES!** But, just attending church each Sunday (or occasional Sundays) is not a recipe for growing into a healthy follower of Jesus who walks into the world with God's hope. We need to find a smaller and deeper community for belonging and connection, active and purposeful servanthood with meaning, and intentional and deeper discipleship to be formed in our faith. This day is an opportunity to lean into connecting, growing, serving, and sharing life as we follow Jesus! This is how we get tethered to a local church long-term!

So what is RE-CONNECT Sunday REIMAGINED? In the past, we hosted this event at 9:00 AM before our worship gathering. For some, that is a hard starting time and limited participation. So, we are planning for our **RE-CONNECT** gathering to happen **right after the morning service**.

We will end our 10:30 AM worship gathering gathered around the table of the Lord's Supper. We then will move to the fellowship hall to gather for mission, ministry, and connection! We will share light refreshments (after all, Jesus spent a lot of time with his followers around food!) and have an opportunity to become more aware of the ministries of our church and the places where we each can grow and serve. And all of us are called to grow and serve!

So, will you mark September 13th for **RE-CONNECT Sunday**? This format will provide a greater opportunity for as many people as possible to **RE-CONNECT** and **REIMAGINE** sharing life, ministry, and mission together, seeking to become like Jesus, **SHARING GOD'S HOPE WHEREVER WE FIND OURSELVES!**

But wait there's more!!!

ARE YOU A VOICE OF HOPE?

On September 13th, we will also begin a series of sermons, **VOICES OF HOPE**. Why should we have hope, and how can the world see that hope through us?

We exist to share God's hope wherever we find ourselves. But how do we do that? This fall, we have an opportunity to be equipped for our mission through our Adult Journey groups. Every group better outfits us for our mission but consider two groups that are meeting on Sundays beginning September 20th at 9:00 AM!

NOT BEYOND REACH is a curriculum that invites us to look at the world through the lens of a world that is rejecting Christianity and the church. How do you share God's hope when people don't want to listen to you because you are a Christian? The other group is a study of the prophets **JONAH, JOEL & AMOS**, who spoke into a world much like ours. What do we learn from them to engage our world, but also to consider the church and ways we need to repent to be the agents of hope needed?

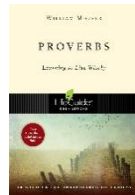

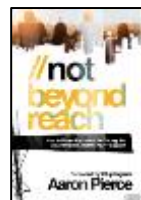
FALL SUNDAY JOURNEY GROUPS – BEGINS SEPTEMBER 20TH

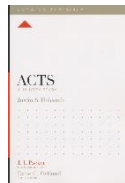
NOT BEYOND REACH



"Not Beyond Reach" group will **begin on September 20th at 9:00 AM in Room 306**. He explains how discipleship relationships start even before a friend or loved one accepts Christ. As you build trust over time, you open doors to share the Gospel. Aaron begins by demystifying the underlying inconsistencies and idols at the heart of secular beliefs. Then he outlines a new playbook for reaching the next generation and others who would not walk into a church. The process involves intentionality and radical dependence on the Holy Spirit and God to move. It also involves authentic relationships and perceptive listening and communication skills. *Not Beyond Reach* provides examples and strategies to help readers progress from friendship conversations to spiritual conversations to Gospel conversations that transform lives. MOM'S GROUP

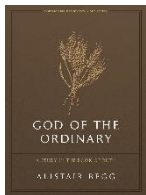
