

## COVID PROTOCOLS UPDATE - June 13, 2021

Looking back over the last year and a half we have consistently sought, to the best of our ability, to love others well, *especially the vulnerable*. The Church board and staff have actively sought the guidance of the CDC, NH Governor's office and the City of Nashua, in order to determine our policies and protocol. Forward looking, we are in an improved state than we were a year ago. Given this the Church leadership, in seeking God's will and seeking to love our neighbor have, through prayer, discernment and discussion, concluded that at this time we can begin a gradual process of easing some of our current protocols including.

1. Gradually increasing seating capacity as the data supports it.
2. Removing plexiglass barriers on the platform and, due to safe distancing, those that are fully vaccinated on the platform will not be wearing masks.
3. Scaling back COVID signage and social distancing stickers.
4. Posting, but no longer asking, COVID screening questions when entering to worship.

We still continue to love each other well. At this time that means:

1. The continued disinfecting of the church.
2. Maintaining the social distancing policy.
3. Maintaining the registration for the service.
4. Maintaining our mask requirement.

We all are all still tasked with staying home if:

1. We do not feel well
2. Have traveled abroad
3. Have been exposed to a person with COVID.

We believe that this incremental easing will slowly allow us to move forward to normality. Please do be aware that if there is a sudden spike in cases or sudden change in regional circumstances, these policies may be brought back.

The Church leadership is staying apprised of the trends and statistics, and as they continue in the right direction we will evaluate the continued easing of our policies.
