"Lent: Limping to Easter"



Lent. We began this journey on Ash Wednesday. This strange season of the year where we talk about doing without in a world of celebrated indulgence, ponder what feels like archaic words like sin and repentance, and come face to face with our mortality, in the form of Ashes, in a culture obsessed with finding a fountain of youth.

"For you are dust,
and you will return to dust."
Genesis 3:19

But this is about being honest with ourselves about...

Our human limitation. Our sinful condition.
Our repentant position. Our Lord's redemption.

We discover our "limp". We intentionally embrace what I am calling "the limp" toward the empty tomb. But we limp with hope because we do know the end of the story. And so, as we move through Lent, we will recall what God has to say to us about this journey and God's sustaining grace. We will grab hold of some truths that serve as a "walking stick" to support us as we limp. And the goal? To recognize that in our limp there is still joy to be found, holiness to embrace, and grace to live for Jesus each day.




PROCESS FOR CHURCH LEADERSHIP SELECTIONS – March 22, 2026

We will be holding elections on March 22, 2026. This will constitute part one of the annual meeting (Manual paragraph 113.7) and allow for a more efficient process for closing out the church year. The following is the process we will be following:

1. The membership of the Community Chapel Church of the Nazarene will be electing three (3) members to the Church Board for three-year terms and, as needed, delegates to the District Assembly and District Nazarene Missions International Convention.
2. Selection of leaders will take place on March 22, 2026.
3. Each active member who is 15 years old and older (having been through membership training and officially received into membership) will be asked to verify their membership status. They will then be given a ballot and asked to vote. Upon completion of their voting, their ballot will be received in a confidential manner. Votes will be counted that day and clear elections posted at www.community-chapel.org by the following Tuesday. There is no absentee or online balloting.
4. In the event there is a tie for any position, a ballot for breaking the tie will be conducted as soon as possible.
5. If possible, sample ballots and biographical sketches of the candidates for church board will be made available the week of leadership selections, March 15th.

HOSPICE CARE PRESENTATION – FRIDAY, MARCH 13th at 11:30 AM FELLOWSHIP HALL

Hospice Care is a Gift to Yourself, Your Loved One and Your Family

While hospice care is a benefit that is covered by most health insurance plans, only half of eligible beneficiaries access this valuable resource at all. 25% of beneficiaries do not access the hospice benefit until the very last week of life. Why might this be? Many people do not know what hospice includes, how it works, or whether they or a loved one might be eligible. They may wait for a provider referral, or they may struggle with accepting a diagnosis. This presentation will address these issues as well as ways to talk with one another as health declines, what is most helpful as one gets closer to the end of life, and how to continue to communicate and be close as death nears. There will be time for questions and conversation around this sometimes-uncomfortable subject. Come with your questions. Leave better informed.

Presenter: Lynne Randall, MS, MSW, BCD has worked with hospice for over 20 years, initially as a Palliative Care Social Worker, later as a Manager of Social Work and Spiritual Care, and lastly, as a Hospice Chaplain.


WINTER SUNDAY JOURNEY GROUPS

This group meets on **Sundays at 9:00 AM in Room 302**. **“That the World May Know”** is a video series, where Ray Vander Laan is the fun and engaging tour guide. He will take you on a trip to ancient times, places, and customs. No book is necessary for this group.



This group meets on **Sundays at 9:00 AM in Room 305** and will be studying **Hebrews: A 12-Week Study**. The book of Hebrews stands apart from other biblical books in its theologically unique portrait of Jesus Christ as the supreme revelation of God - a portrait bolstered by the author's skilled use of imagery, metaphor, and Old Testament analogy. This group meets on **Sundays at 9:00 AM in Room 306** and will be studying **Not Beyond Reach** by Aaron Pierce. He explains how discipleship relationships start even before a friend or loved one accepts Christ. As you build trust over time, you open doors to share the Gospel. Aaron begins by demystifying the underlying inconsistencies and idols at the heart of secular beliefs. Then he outlines a new playbook for reaching the next generation and others who would not walk into a church. The process involves intentionality and radical dependence on the Holy Spirit and God to move. It also involves authentic relationships and perceptive listening and communication skills. *Not Beyond Reach* provides examples and strategies to help readers progress from friendship conversations to spiritual conversations to Gospel conversations that transform lives. 
WEDNESDAY EVENING WOMEN'S GROUP

sin, and death on our behalf - a truth that gives us great hope for the future. This book can be purchased online at Christianbooks.com or [Amazon](http://Amazon.com).


SATURDAY MORNINGS MOM'S GROUP




WEDNESDAY MEN'S JOURNEY GROUP
