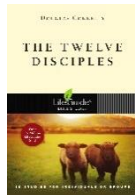
SAVE THE DATE: YOUNG ADULTS LASER TAG & CAMPFIRE COMMUNITY NIGHT

THE TWELVE DISCIPLES



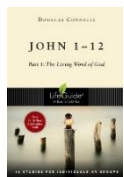

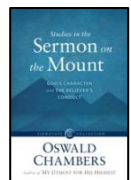
MEN'S TUESDAY NIGHT JOURNEY GROUP

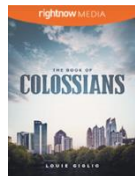
