IN A SHEPHERD'S WORD

Prayer: Let us remember...this is US!

This week, I wanted to publish the prayer I prayed this past Sunday, following the killing of Charlie Kirk. I leave it with you to consider and to pray...

In this world where **us vs. them** demands the loudest voice, we have witnessed another act of political violence. But **the truth is, Lord, it is not us vs. them. It is simply us.** Not Republican. Democrat. Independent. It is US.

We mourn the violence that killed Charlie Kirk, a Republican 31-year-old husband, father of two, this week. Just as we mourn the killing of a Democratic Lawmaker, Melissa Hortman, and her spouse in Minnesota three months ago. Lord, have mercy on these families. And Lord, stay the hand and words of retribution and revenge and political violence. We as a people cannot survive that. As Paul wrote: If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other. (Galatians 5:15)

We mourn and are angry about the rhetoric that tears us apart and creates enemies out of family, friends, and neighbors. The social media hand grenades, the flame-thrower words, especially from politicians and people in positions of power and social media influence, need to stop. Enough. In the name of Christ, forbear!

We mourn the thirst for power that disregards your beautiful image in us all. The fear-mongering and attacks simply because someone is different...politically ...ethnically...religiously.

But Lord, we know that change begins with your people and how we act and respond. Lord, let us follow the words of Scripture to the people of God: If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. (2 Chronicles 7:14)

This begins with your people. Us. We confess, the church has too often been complicit, in the name of Jesus, in this culture of animosity and rage and hate. Let us not embrace this, endorse this, or look away in the name of political party or power. Let us turn from the consequentialism that says the ends justify the means. This is not the Kingdom of God! Let us be different.

Lord, help us, by the power of your Spirit to...be different in our treatment of others...sound different with the words we use in disagreement...do different by doing justice, loving mercy and walking humbly...humbly...with our God.

I don't know what else to do but to turn to you, the one who will bring all things into unity and make all things right. For you are the answer.

In the midst of this world that is so much not as it ought to be, we also pray for those who have walked through, or are walking through, the darkest valleys. In the midst of all the noise, we lift those among us who need a bit of grace in the shadows of their suffering, disease, grief, and pain. For as the noise rages around us, those next to us and near us, however they voted, whatever they look like, wherever they are from, are just like us, facing the hardships and challenges of life. Let us not forget that. Let us not forget them.

Let us remember...this is US! In your eyes, **there is no us vs. them**. Only us, all made in your image. All in need of grace. So, help us to be more like you. Amen.






