#### **CALL TO CONFESSION**

MATTHEW 3

THE NEW TESTAMENT MATTHEW 3:1-6 JOHN THE BAPTIST PROCLAIMS

John the Baptist preached repentance in the wilderness of Judea because the kingdom of heaven was near. His ministry fulfilled the prophecy in Isaiah, where

a voice cries out to "Prepare the way of the Lord." He preached a message of repentance, a spiritual and moral turning away from sin, because the kingdom of heaven is at hand. People from all over the region, including Jerusalem, came to be baptized by John after confessing their sins.

In those days, John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness of Judea, proclaiming, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near." This is the one of whom the prophet Isaiah spoke when he said,

"The voice of one crying out in the wilderness:

'Prepare the way of the Lord; make his paths straight.'"

Now John wore clothing of camel's hair with a leather belt around his waist, and his food was locusts and wild honey. Then Jerusalem and all Judea and all the region around the Jordan were going out to him, and they were baptized by him in the River Jordan, confessing their sins.

THE OLD TESTAMENT GENESIS 3:1-7 RIGHTEOUS REIGN OF ONE COMING

In the beginning, God created perfection. Then came the serpent's temptation and the fall of humanity. The cunning serpent deceived Eve into disobeying God's command by twisting God's Word to suggest that God was withholding something good. Eve ate the fruit, shared it with Adam, and the couple realized their nakedness with shame. This event ushered in sin, separation from God.

Now the serpent was more crafty than any other wild animal that the Lord God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God say, 'You shall not eat from any tree in the garden'?" The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat of the fruit of the trees in the garden, but God said, 'You shall not eat of the fruit of the tree that is in the middle of the garden, nor shall you touch it, or you shall die.' "But the serpent said to the woman, "You will not die, for God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food and that it was a delight to the eyes and that the tree was to be desired to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate, and she also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate. Then the eyes of both were opened, and they knew that they were naked, and they sewed fig leaves together and made loincloths for themselves.
