"EVEN THE WIND AND WAVES OBEY HIM" PASTOR BRANDON WAY

Jesus' first miracles in chronological order:

- Jesus turns water into wine.
- Jesus heals an official's son in Capernaum.
- Jesus drives out an evil spirit in Capernaum.
- Jesus heals Peter's mother.
- Jesus heals many who are sick and oppressed at night.
- First miraculous catch of fish.
- Jesus heals a man with leprosy.
- Jesus heals the centurion's paralyzed servant.
- Jesus heals the paralytic who was lowered in from the roof.
- Jesus heals a man with a withered hand on the Sabbath.
- Jesus raises a widow's son from the dead.

That day when evening came, he said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side." Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him. A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped. Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?"

He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm.

He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?"
