### Welcome

Let's get to know each other. (15 min)

If your group eats together, use this question during your meal:

Q: Share your name and one of your favorite movies and one reason why you like it?

### Worship

Let's enter the presence of God together.  
(10-15 min)

Take some time and read Psalm 8. What sticks out to you in this Psalm about the relationship God has with humans?

### Word

Let's interact with God's Word. (40 min)

Read the story about the disciples in Matthew 20:20-28.

1. How do you feel about the mother's request for her sons?
2. How did the other disciples feel about it when they heard about it?
3. What revolutionary idea did Jesus introduce to the disciples?
4. Do you think the idea of being a servant of all is revolutionary for today? Why/why not?

Read Colossians 3:12-14

5. List the attributes that Paul tells us to put on in these verses.
6. What attribute pulls the ensemble together?
7. What attribute do you find easiest to put on? Which one is most difficult?

Read Colossians 3:18-25

8. For Husbands and wives, what does it mean to submit to one another and love each other as Christ loved us?
9. For parents with children, what does it mean to not embitter your children?
10. The words *slave* and *master* can be substituted for *worker* and *boss*... when we work, who are we really serving? Is that your attitude at work?
11. What part of this “Revolution in Relationships” is most challenging for you?
12. What do you sense the Lord saying to you in this study?

### Witness

Let's focus on who we can reach out to.  
(10 min)

Maybe it's to try to reconnect with them. Maybe it's to invite them to come to your Life Together Group. Maybe it's to pray for their situation. Is there someone you feel God is calling you to reach out to this week?

If God is impressing a certain person on your heart today, what are you willing to do to follow that leading?

Pray for one another and for those you sense God is calling you to reach out to!
