## CODE OF CONDUCT

The Youth Ministers of the Overland Park Church recognize the importance of rules and policies to insure the safety of all students and participants involved in official OP Youth activities. This list explains what is acceptable and what is unacceptable within the Youth Minister's realm of influence. These standards apply for all of our group activities and overnight trips.

### Behavior expectations include:

- Participation with the group in all group activities.
- The development of wholesome relationships.
- Showing the proper respect for all adult sponsors and student peers.
- Helping to keep the facilities and vehicles clean.

### Behavior we will not tolerate includes:

- Bullying (physical or mental harm)
- Illegal substance consumption (alcohol, narcotics, tobacco of any form)
- Sexual Promiscuity (public or non-public displays of affection)
- Disobeying any rules or guidelines set by the Youth Ministers at any time

If an individual chooses to behave contrary to these guidelines, the Youth Ministers in authority will exercise appropriate disciplinary measures. The disciplinary measures could include the withholding of privileges or not allowing student to participate in the event in the future. At any time, the Youth Ministers have the right to send any student home from an event at his/her parent's expense. If necessary, police will be called if any illegal activities take place. Youth Ministers reserve the right to search your personal possessions if reasonable suspicion arises.
