Elders' Report

Each elder is assigned a number of members of the congregation to his or her personal care group for regular follow up. Maintaining open and meaningful communication with the congregation is very important to us.

Additionally in 2025 the elder board decided to also add regularly attending non members to our care groups lists. We felt it important they have access to the same spiritual care members of the congregation receive from the elders. If these non members decide later to become members of Messiah they will not transfer to another care group or elder, but will simply be added to the membership role. We have had good response to this change. Our elders will continue to work toward building solid relationships with guests and newcomers.

Starting in 2026 the elder board has decided to change our online Teams meeting schedule from quarterly to three times during the year. We feel this will still allow the elder board opportunity to cover all necessary business, while freeing up some time for other needs. In the event a pressing issue arises between scheduled meetings we will call a special meeting to handle that need. We are scheduled to meet on second Thursdays in April, August, and November.
