Connect With Serving: Everybody has unique gifts, abilities, and talents. However, few discover them until later in life. We want to enable students to experience volunteerism designed to help them discover their areas of strength and potential within a ministry context. This valuable time of equipping is a starting place for what Paul teaches in Ephesians 4:11-13. (20-30 minutes)

Connect With Each Other: Proverbs 13:20 describes how our friends play a vital role in the quality of our lives. Building relationships with other students and adult group leaders is a key component of genuine community. We aim to create an environment where every student experiences a rich sense of belonging. During this time of connecting, we will participate in games, snacks, conversations, or activities designed for relational growth. (15-20 minutes)

Connect With God's Word: The Bible is the only authoritative source of truth. God has spoken and has revealed Himself through His Word. This time of connecting with God's Word will teach students truths and principles directly from the Bible. Trusted authors, scholars, pastors, and biblical commentators will help guide each student's learning. We are praying for life-changing spiritual growth as described in Hebrews 4:12. (20-30 minutes)

Connect As Groups: This time will be similar to the discussion time spent in our weekly Community Groups offered throughout Advance Community Church. The students' small groups are designed to apply the biblical truths learned in the "Connect with God's Word" portion. Hebrews 10:23-25 reveals an important insight to gospel-centered community. This will be a dynamic time of Q&A, discussion, encouragement, and prayer. There will be a community group of middle school girls, high school girls, and a group for guys. (45-50 minutes)
