THOUGHTS FROM PASTOR AARON

James 5:7-8a

- Carter Cleaning will be called and a deep sanitation of the church will be completed.
- Staff/Congregants will be asked to remain home for quarantined protocol that is recommended by the Dept. of Health.
- Quarantine requirements for church services/activities will be determined & communicated by the PCHD.
