CHURCH BUILDING IS OPEN THIS SUNDAY

We are so thankful as a church that we are able to meet together again in person on Sunday for worship. We closed our building last week out of an abundance of caution after a person who had been in the building during the week tested positive for Covid. There have been no new cases associated with our church, so after consulting with the Health Department and sanitizing the building, we are cleared to have services in our sanctuary again.

Please note:

- Sunday morning worship times—8:30 am & 11:00 am
- Sunday School at 9:45am. All classes are practicing social distancing. Due to low attendance in the children's classes, some are being combined—signs are posted outside the rooms.
- Children's Church is available for ages PreK through 3rd grade.
- We are asking everyone to wear a mask and practice social distancing in the church building. There will be empty pews between rows with usher-guided seating/dismissal. The sanctuary will be sanitized between services.
- The nursery will not be staffed, but will be available for families to use during services if needed.
- Offering plates will not be passed but will be available for you to use on your way in or out of the sanctuary.
- We will continue to offer online services on our Facebook and website for those hesitant or unable to attend in person.



COVID-19 Plan

In the event that a staff member or congregant/visitor of E1COG is diagnosed with COVID-19 the following steps shall be taken:

- 1. The individual should notify the Preble County Dept of Health 937.472.0087
- 2. The individual should notify the church office 937.456.4681
- 3. If individual had attended church in the past 10 days, an email should be sent to the church members notifying them that a person has been diagnosed with Covid-19.
- 4. Carter Cleaning will be called and a deep sanitation of the church will be completed.
- 5. Staff/Congregants will be asked to remain home for quarantined protocol that is recommended by the Dept. of Health.
- Quarantine requirements for church services/activities will be determined & communicated by the PCHD.
