The DoorWay is a Christ-centered ministry that has faithfully served our community for over 26 years, bringing hope and practical help to youth, individuals struggling with addiction, and families affected by alcoholism and substance abuse. Through prevention, counseling, training, and support programs, they provide essentials such as clothing, food, Bibles, and school supplies while pointing people to the life-changing hope found in Jesus.

Recently, The DoorWay experienced a major disaster when a severe roof leak caused extensive damage throughout their building. Ten rooms were affected, including ceilings and floors, forcing the ministry to close its doors on December 17, 2025. For the first time in 26 years, they were unable to host their annual Christmas party for the families they serve. Repairs are urgently needed so this vital ministry can reopen and continue helping individuals and families in crisis in our community.
