PASTORAL CARE

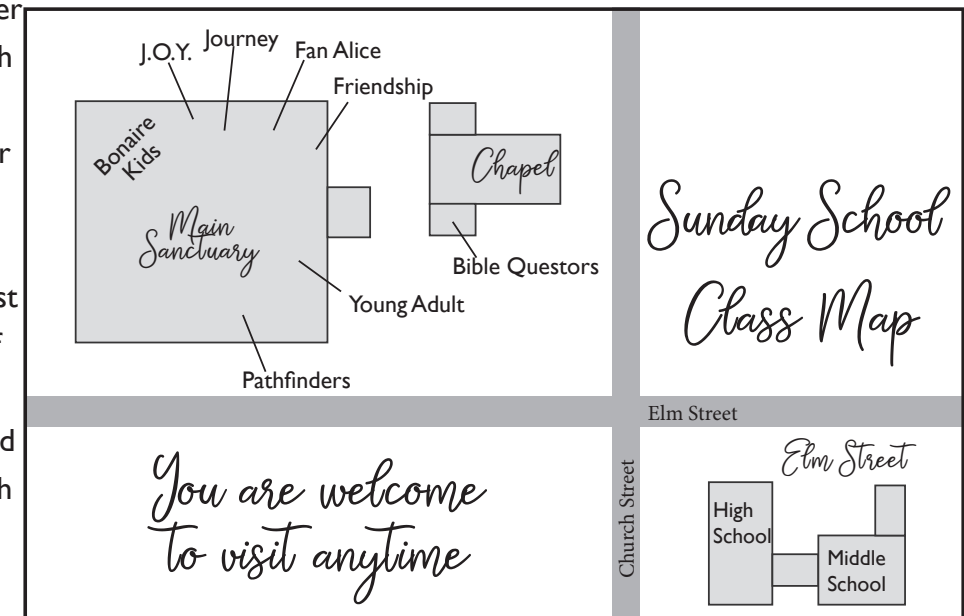
