complain about the role the referees played in eliminating them from the big game. But, next weekend is also an opportunity to get things right...

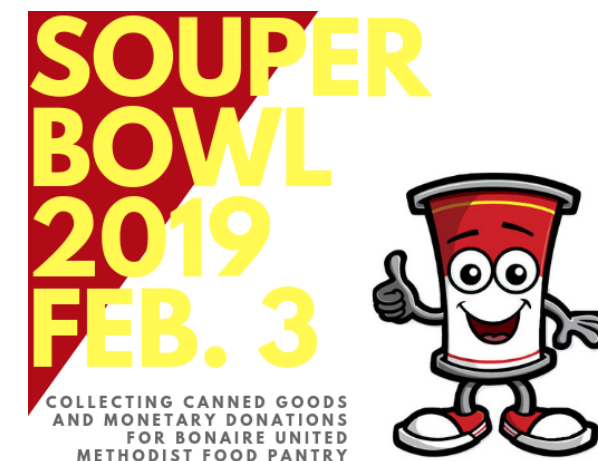
