EPIPHANY

As I write this, we are on the eve of Epiphany. This small celebration is on January 6th every year, or thirteen days after Christmas. It is a time that we celebrate the visit of the Magi to see the baby Jesus; they had the "epiphany!" This Epiphany season lasts this year until February 21, which is the first Lenten Sunday, taking us into Easter.

During this season, I would like to encourage you to spend time remembering your personal "epiphany" of Jesus Christ as Savior. Where did you meet him? How old were you? How did it make you feel? How were you changed? As an evangelical, I believe that the personal "epiphany" is a crucial part of the saving process: the moment Christ draws you to Him. It is important to note that while the Magi found Christ, Christ revealed himself to them. The Spirit's work in your life results in bringing you some place, like the star of Bethlehem and then Christ reveals himself to you. He opens your eyes.

Even though manger scenes are now disappearing from lawns all across our communities, and folk are settling in for the three months of winter, we can still spend time like the Magi, bringing others to see Christ revealed so that they may "fall down and worship Him." (Matthew 2:11) I encourage you to walk daily with the beautiful scene of the manger in your hearts as we now begin the long sojourn to the cross and then revel in the triumph of Easter! (April 4)
