 (Bridge:) Come re-joice now, O my soul, For his love is my re-ward.

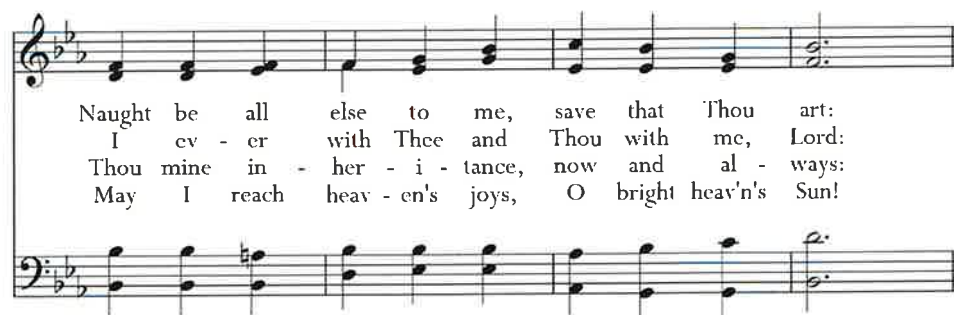
Fear is gone and hope is sure: Christ is mine for-ev-er-more. *repeat, then go to 3b*

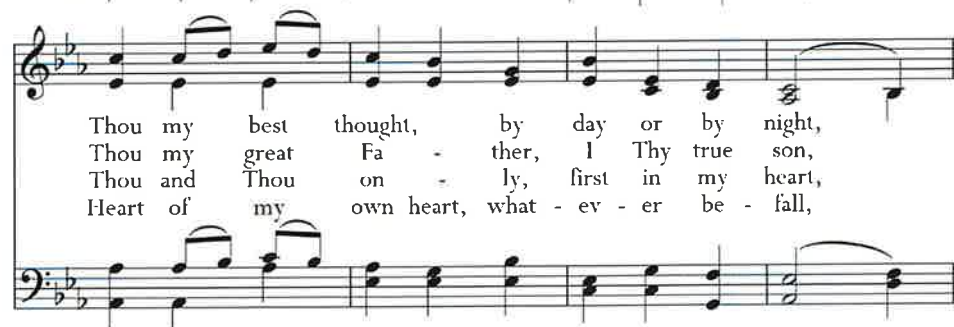

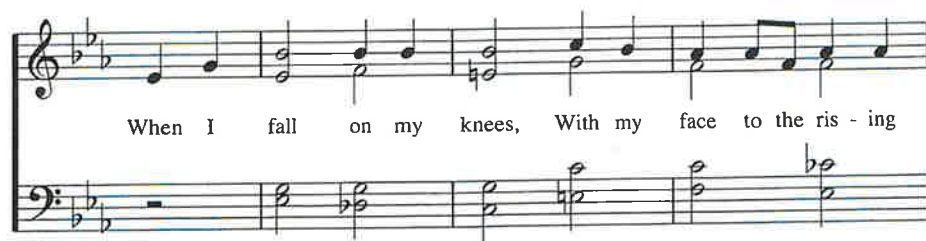
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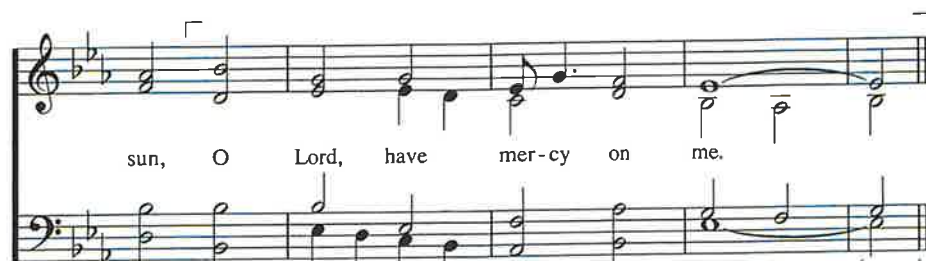
