The Gospel

The Gospel is the joyous declaration
that God is redeeming the world through Christ
and that He commands everyone everywhere
to repent from sin and trust Jesus Christ for salvation.

But because of his love, God sent His Son, Jesus,
to live, for His people's sake, the perfect, obedient life God requires
and to die on the cross in our place for our sin.


