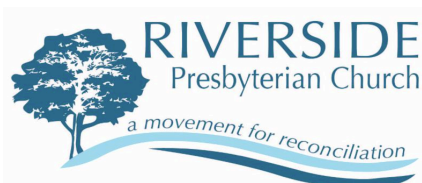


RPC Stages of Re-opening
