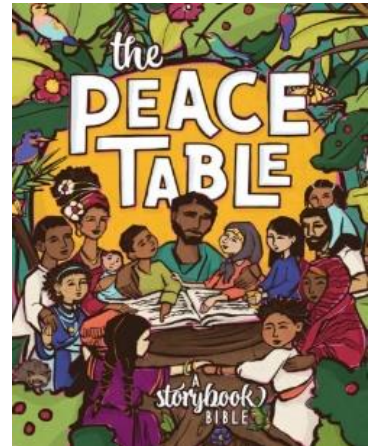
Wednesday Night Live
