



Mamma Mia Policies

Mamma Mia is a free ministry of Calvary Baptist Church. This ministry exists to provide support and encouragement to mothers of young children. Mamma Mia operates each Thursday beginning at 9:00AM until 12:00PM.

Mamma Mia will follow the district calendar of Snyder ISD. If SISD cancels classes due to inclement weather, illness, etc., Mamma Mia will follow suit, unless otherwise indicated.

Parents will enter the building at the KidsZone check in area and then walk their child/children to their class(es). Each child must be checked in by their parent upon entering and checked out by their parent upon leaving. If you need to make alternative arrangements for your child to be checked out by someone other than the parent/guardian that checked them in, you will need to make arrangements at the time of drop off.

Children will have a designated space to keep their belongings (ie. Diaper bags, backpacks, etc.). Please make sure each bag is labeled with the child's first and last name. We ask that you send any needed personal supplies with your child (wet wipes, diapers, pull-ups, bottles & formula, sippy cup, etc.)

Each child will need to bring their own lunch. Please send finger food type lunches that do not need to be heated, cut-up, etc. All food allergies MUST be indicated on the registration form and updated on the child's Mamma Mia profile immediately.

A snack will be provided for each child, Little Tots and up, unless otherwise communicated by the parent during drop off. Please ensure your child brings a sippy cup with their name on it.

Parents are asked to include any allergies, special diets, and/or emergency health information at the time of registration and update this information as needed.

Momma Mia Classes:

1. Babies: Infants - Crawlers*
2. Little Tots: Walking - 2 years
3. Big Tots: 3 - 4 years

*Babies will move up to the Little Tots class when they begin walking.

A child who becomes ill will be separated from other children and the parent will be contacted immediately.

Children who are sick or showing symptoms of illness will not be permitted to attend Mamma Mia. The following is a list of symptoms that will prohibit the child's attendance at Mamma Mia:

1. Vomiting or diarrhea. Student must be symptom free for 24 hours, without medication before re-entry
2. Temperature of 100.0 or greater when taken on the forehead
3. Any undiagnosed rash
5. Red, draining eyes
6. Intense itching with signs and symptoms of secondary infection
7. Open, draining lesions or wounds
8. Lice
9. For any infection, antibiotics must be taken for a minimum of 24 hours prior to re-admittance
10. Discharge from the eyes/ears or profuse nasal discharge
11. Symptoms of possible communicable disease such as lethargy, abnormal breathing, mouth sores with drooling, sniffles, sore throat, headache and abdominal pain with fever, behavior changes or other signs that the child may be severely ill.

Mamma Mia volunteers will not administer any medication to children during their time in our care.
