### FROM THE PASTOR

While the world recognizes January as the start of a new year, Easter signifies new beginnings on the Christian calendar. As believers, it is from this day that our weeks, years, and lives are guided. All the gospels confirm the truth that Jesus rose from the dead on the first day of the week. That is why, from the earliest days of the church, Christians gathered on Sunday rather than on the Jewish Sabbath, which is observed on Saturday. Each week marks a mini-Easter celebration. As we prepare to celebrate Easter, we first observe Good Friday. On this day, Jesus bore the weight of the world on His shoulders as the true Passover Lamb, the perfect sacrifice to atone for a world separated from God by sin.
