### FROM THE PASTOR

So much happens in May. Floydada CISD Senior Recognition, Baccalaureate, Graduation, Mother's Day, Food Box Distribution, Memorial Day, Beehive Service, the Lord's Supper, West Texas Ministers Retreat, end-of-year parties, Deacons' meeting, Handbells, Old Settlers Day. This doesn't even include all the doctors' appointments, Little League games, crop insurance documents, spraying, irrigation, planting, plowing, moving cattle, and the list could go on and on. In a word, BUSY. It is far too easy to get wrapped up in the BUSY and lose sight of what's important. In fact, in our culture today, BUSY can even be rewarded or looked upon as a virtue. This is the story we find in Luke 10:38-41, the story of Mary and Martha. Martha was BUSY serving her guests and became distracted and frustrated that her sister Mary wasn't helping. This frustration led her to call out to Christ, "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself? Tell her to help me!" Many times, when we are BUSY, we find ourselves in the same boat as Martha. If only someone could be made to share my burdens, everything would be all right. But Jesus, rightly, reminded Martha that she was worried about many things, and her sister Mary had found the one thing that mattered most. That was spending time at the foot of Jesus, and Jesus would not take that away from her! When life starts to feel overwhelming, we need to remember this story. We can be worried about many things, and those worries can cause us to lash out at others, when what we really need is to sit at the feet of Jesus and find strength in Him. For Christ calls us to, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." (Matthew 11:28-30)
