### Pentecost Sunday

All are invited to **wear red** to church **next Sunday, May 24th**, as we celebrate the **Day of Pentecost**. Red is the traditional color for Pentecost because it symbolizes the Holy Spirit, especially the "tongues, as of fire" that came upon the disciples in the Acts of the Apostles. Pentecost celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit and the Church being sent out into the world to proclaim the Gospel. We hope you will join us in wearing red as a visible sign of this joyful feast day.

This year, we also invite anyone who speaks a language other than English to take part in reading the Acts lesson in multiple languages, reflecting the diversity and unity shown at Pentecost.
