What is a Deanery

As we prepare to celebrate the installation of our new bishop, you'll hear the word *deanery* quite a bit. A deanery is simply a group of neighboring Episcopal churches that work together for fellowship, shared ministry, and mutual support. St. Wilfrid's is part of Deanery 10: Coastal/South Orange County, which includes twelve churches from Seal Beach to San Clemente, as well as Irvine and Rancho Santa Margarita.
