Our Next Bishop

The Diocese of Los Angeles is currently in the discernment and search process for our next bishop. At our Annual Parish Meeting in January, St. Wilfrid's elected two delegates to represent us at the upcoming Diocesan Convention in November, with a third delegate appointed by the Vestry. After a bishop is elected, the wider Episcopal Church must give consent. A majority of both diocesan standing committees and bishops must approve the election. Once consent is received, the new bishop will be consecrated in a special service, officially beginning their ministry. Starting next Sunday, we'll include a prayer in worship for this important and prayerful process.
