This year, *Voices of Advent*, by Matthew Skinner, has been chosen for the Advent Book Study. In his newest book, Skinner takes us through biblical texts and explores how various voices in the Bible prepare us for Advent and shape our lives and Christmas celebrations. Over three weeks, we will hear Jesus' teaching as he promises to return to us in the future, to John the Baptist as he prepares the way for the Messiah, to the faithful people and poets who anticipate the miraculous birth, and to the angels and visionaries who praise God when Christmas dawns.
