Adult Choir

The Adult Choir is one of the most visible ministries of FPC Delray Beach. With a core of dedicated professionals led by Don Cannarozzi, they also have many volunteers who just love to sing. They call themselves “The Church Family Choir” and are always looking for new family members.

Children’s Choir

Children’s Choir joyfully welcomes all children ages six to twelve in Sunday morning rehearsals during the school year, culminating in participation in services throughout the year, as well as presenting a Christmas Pageant or Musical in the beginning of December. They encourage all children to “make a joyful noise unto God!”

The Men’s Fellowship is an opportunity for fellowship with their church family and a chance to read meditations and books to further their goal of becoming better disciples. Past missions they have participated in include developing a lending library, contributing to upgrading our sound system, and cooking hotdogs for our Rummage Sale.

Mission Outreach

Serving God’s people locally and beyond is the purpose of the Mission Outreach Ministry through oversight of mission funds, service projects, and mission trips. Their primary focus is addressing issues of hunger, homelessness, families in crisis, children, and disaster assistance by partnering with community service providers.
