- April 7** Yours is the Kingdom and the Glory and the Power [NKJV]

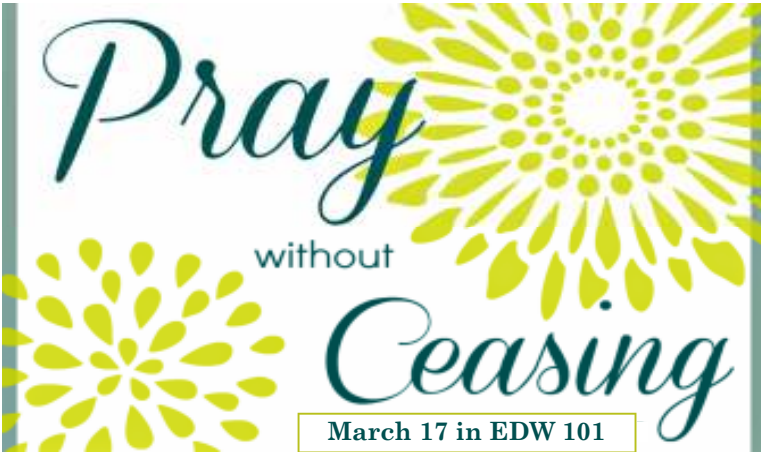
