**Ephesians 4:11-12** (NIV) "So Christ Himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, <u>to equip</u> His people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up."

#### **TALK IT OVER:**

- **1.** Read Ephesians 4:11-12. What is the stated role of the ministry leaders mentioned in this passage? What is the stated goal for the church body in this passage?
- **2.** Read the definition of EQUIP (above). Why is it important for the church to have leaders who focus on equipping?
- **3.** How does our mission (to Reach, Teach, Connect, & Send) help us to think strategically about equipping disciples?
- **4.** Take a moment to remember/review the illustration about the U.T. football coaches coming onto the field to receive the kick-off. What's wrong with this picture? How does it help us understand the distinctive roles of pastors and disciples?
- 5. The Next Steps Classes lead disciples to make four commitments: Plugged-In (a commitment to a church family), Q.T. (a commitment to a daily Quiet Time with Christ), MAGNIFY (a commitment to glorifying God with our time, talents and treasure), and Witness Training (a commitment to witness for Christ).
