- 4)** Read Ephesians 4:11-19. What is the purpose of the apostles, evangelists, pastors and teachers, etc.? Ponder for a moment some of challenges the culture is currently throwing at Christians. How does being fully mature in Christ impact the way we respond to these challenges?
- 5)** Read Ephesians 5. What does it mean to “live as children of light?”
