#1. Jesus is In The Flesh!
Hebrews 1:3a (NIV) "The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact
representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word."
#2. Jesus is to Moses & The Law
Hebrews 3:5-6 (NLT) "Moses was certainly faithful in God's house as a servant.
His work was an illustration of the truths God would reveal later. But Christ, as
the Son, is in charge of God's entire house. And we are God's house, if we keep
our courage and remain confident in our hope in Christ."
#3. Jesus Is The High Priest & Sacrifice for Sin!
Hebrews 7:24-25 (NIV) "But because Jesus lives forever, he has a permanent priesthood. Therefore, he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them."
Hebrews 9:11-12 (NIV) "But when Christ came as high priest of the good things that are now already here, he went through the greater and more perfect tabernacle that is not made with human hands, that is to say, is not a part of this creation. He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption."
#4. A Heart-felt Call To In Faith!
Hebrews 10:35-36 (NIV) "So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richled rewarded. You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised."
HALL OF (Hebrews 11)

Hebrews 11:1-2 (NIV) "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. 2 This is what the ancients were commended for."

Hebrews 12:1-2 (NIV) "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."

#5. A Simple--Final Word of Instruction: Live _____ For Jesus!

Hebrews 13:15-16 (NIV) "Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name. And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased."

Hebrews 13:20-21 (NIV) "Now may the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen."
