# **Cookeville Pregnancy Clinic Drive**



#### **TALK IT OVER**

- **1.** (Revelation 1:4-5a) What does the phrase the "One who is and who was and who is to come," reveal about God's timeless nature and His presence in our lives today? How can this perspective impact our faith and daily walk?
- **2.** (Revelation 1:13-16) How does this imagery of the glorified Jesus reveal both His divinity and His authority over all creation? In what ways can this understanding influence our worship and submission to Him?
- **3.** (Revelation 1:17-18) How can Jesus' assurance to John in this passage, encourage us to be faithful witnesses even in challenging circumstances?
- **4.** (Revelation 1:19-20) How does knowing that Jesus, and his ministering angels are among us (the church), encourage, challenge and/or inspire you?
- **5.** (Daniel 7:13-14) This passage is a great example of the a Messianic prophecy that Jesus will fulfill at his second advent. Read this passage slowing. Ponder the images it paints, and discuss the impression(s) it makes upon you.
