Although our drive is over, The Cookeville Pregnancy Clinic will always be in need of supplies. If you would like to continue donating supplies you can either drop them off at or mail them to

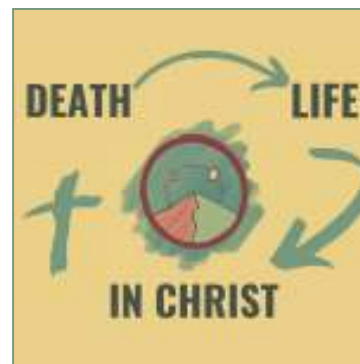
