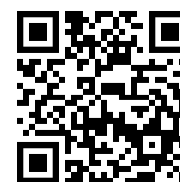

TALK IT OVER

1. John's focus is on theological themes and not necessarily on creating a timeline. How does this perspective change the way we approach the book of Revelation, especially when studying the three sets of seven judgments (Seals, Trumpets, and Bowls)?
2. God sees and will deal with all evil. How does this understanding of God's justice and judgment provide comfort and assurance to believers in every generation?
3. God's wrath is not poured out on the "sealed saints." (Rev. 7:1-4, 2 Cor. 1:21-22, Eph. 1:13) How does this reality parallel with the account of the plagues in Egypt? How can we apply this message of favor and trust to our lives today?
4. Our role is to keep our eyes fixed on God and remain faithful to Him until the end. How can we practically apply this exhortation in our daily lives, especially when facing challenges and temptations?
5. Revelation is a message of hope for both the first-century church and contemporary believers. Share some thoughts from our study of Revelation this week, or past weeks, that have encouraged you in your faith.
