Isaiah 6:1 (NIV) "In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple."

Isaiah 6:2-3 (NIV) "Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. And they were calling to one another: 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory.'"

Isaiah 6:4-5 (NIV) "At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. 'Woe to me!' I cried. 'I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty.'"

Isaiah 6:6-7 (NIV) "Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. With it he touched my mouth and said, 'See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for.'"

Ephesians 1:7 (NIV) "In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace."

Isaiah 6:8 (NIV) "Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?' And I said, 'Here am I. Send me!'"

TALK IT OVER

- **1.** Have you ever experienced a moment when you felt utterly undone by the holiness of God, recognizing your own sinfulness without any excuses or rationalizations?
- **2.** In the light of God's holiness, have you genuinely confessed your sins, acknowledging your need for forgiveness and redemption through the atoning work of Jesus Christ?
- **3.** Reflect on Ephesians 1:7. How does the concept of redemption through the blood of Christ impact your understanding of guilt being taken away and sins being atoned for?
- 4. Consider Isaiah's response to God's question. Can you relate to a moment in your life when you felt a clear calling or mission from God? How did you respond, and how has it shaped your life?
- **5.** If you've experienced conviction, confession, redemption, and a sense of calling, how does this influence your daily life as a witness for Jesus Christ? How can you actively live out your testimony for God's glory in your generation?
