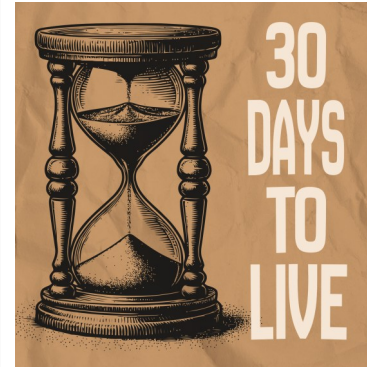

Psalm 39:4–5 (NLT) "Lord, remind me how brief my time on earth will be. Remind me that my days are numbered—how fleeting my life is. You have made my life no longer than the width of my hand. My entire lifetime is just a moment to you; at best, each of us is but a breath."

TALK IT OVER

1. Turning "When" into "Now" -- James 4:13–15 reminds us "life is a mist." What's one "when" you've been waiting on—something you've told yourself you'll do "someday"? How could you turn that into a "now" this week—especially if you knew you only had 30 days left?
2. Being Where You Are -- Psalm 118:24 — "This is the day the Lord has made." Where do you find it hardest to be fully present—with God and/or others? What helps you slow down, listen, and actually rejoice in the moment God's given you?
3. Turning Your Heart Toward Jesus -- 2 Corinthians 6:2 — "Now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation." What would it look like for you to "turn your whole heart toward Jesus" today—not later? Is there an area of your life where He's calling you to act, forgive, or trust Him now?
