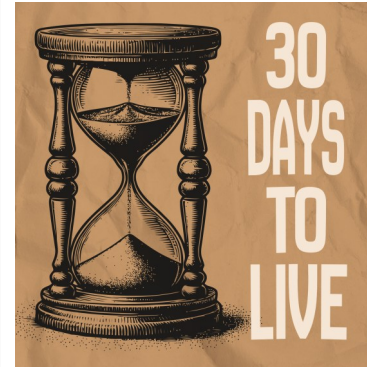

Psalm 39:4-5 (NLT) “LORD, remind me how brief my time on earth will be. Remind me that my days are numbered, and that my life is fleeing away. My life is no longer than the width of my hand. An entire lifetime is just a moment to you; human existence is but a breath.”

Matthew 6:19-21 (NIV, 84) “Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”

Matthew 6:33 (NIV) “But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.”

Three Ways to Seek First His Kingdom:

Way #1. Guard against _____.

Luke 12:20-21 (NIV, 84) “But God said to him, ‘You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?’ 21 This is how it will be with anyone who stores up things for himself but is not rich toward God.”

Way #2. Be _____.

Matthew 25:40 (NIV, 84) “... whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.”

Way #3. Focus on what _____.

Philippians 3:7-8 (NIV, 84) “Whatever was to my profit, I now consider a loss for the sake of Christ. What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them rubbish, that I may gain Christ...”

1 John 2:17 (NIV, 84) “The world and its desires pass away, but the man who does the will of God lives forever.”

TALK IT OVER

1. Psalm 39 reminds us that life is brief—a “breath.” If you truly believed you had only 30 days to live, what would rise to the top of your priorities—and what would suddenly feel less important?
2. Jesus said, “Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” Looking at how you use your time, talents, and money—where would you say your “treasure” is right now? How might God be inviting you to shift your investments toward eternity?
3. Paul called everything else “rubbish” compared to knowing Christ. What would it look like in your daily life to “seek first His Kingdom” (Matthew 6:33)? How can our group encourage one another to focus on what truly matters—loving God and people—in the time we’ve been given?
