

Psalm 39:4-5 (NLT) "LORD, remind me how brief my time on earth will be. Remind me that my days are numbered, and that my life is fleeing away. 5 My life is no longer than the width of my hand. An entire lifetime is just a moment to you; human existence is but a breath."

#1. Say the _____ God wants you to say.

Proverbs 4:20-23 (NIV, 84) "My son, pay attention to what I say; listen closely to my words. Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; for they are life to those who find them and health to a man's whole body. Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life."

Matthew 3:16–17 (NIV) "As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. And a voice from heaven said, "'This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.'"

#2 ____ what God calls us to do.

Romans 7:21–25 (NIV) "So I find this law at work: Although I want to do good, evil is right there with me. For in my inner being I delight in God's law; but I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within me. What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in my sinful nature a slave to the law of sin."

Acts 20:24 (NIV, 84) "However, I consider my life worth nothing to me if only I may finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the gospel of God's grace."

James tells us how to leave a legacy:

James 1:22 (NIV) "Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says."

1 John 2:17 (NIV, 84) "The world and its desires pass away, but the man who does the will of God lives forever."

TALK IT OVER

- 1. Reflecting on Our Brief Time--Psalm 39:4–5 reminds us that life is fleeting. If you truly believed you had only 30 days left to live, what would change about the way you use your words, time, and relationships right now?
- 2. Speaking Life into the Next Generation--God calls us to "speak life" and affirm others—just as the Father affirmed Jesus in Matthew 3:17. Who has spoken life or encouragement into you—and how did it shape your faith? Who in your life might God be calling you to encourage or affirm this week?
- **3.** Doing What God Calls Us to Do--James 1:22 says, "Do not merely listen to the word... do what it says." What step of obedience might God be asking of you right now to leave a lasting legacy of faith?
