

Colossians 2:6 (NIV) “So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him.”

ASPECT 3: To believe in Jesus means to _____ upon Him.

John 6:28-29 (NIV) “Then they asked him, ‘What must we do to do the works God requires?’ Jesus answered, ‘The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent.’”

TALK IT OVER

1. Jesus says, “Why do you call me ‘Lord, Lord,’ and do not do what I say?” (Luke 6:46). Where in your life right now is Jesus inviting you to trust Him with direction, even if you don’t feel spiritually “perfect” yet?
2. Scripture teaches that salvation and life are found in Jesus alone (Acts 4:12; John 14:6). What are some things people—including Christians—are tempted to cling to instead of Jesus, and how can we encourage one another to keep clinging to Him daily?
3. Jesus says the work God desires is simply to believe in the One He sent (John 6:29). What does it look like for you personally to rely on Jesus this week rather than relying on your own strength, plans, or understanding?
