**Matthew 15:7–8 (NIV)** “You hypocrites! Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you: ‘These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me.’”

**3 PRAYERS FOR CONFRONTING HYPOCRISY:**

**Prayer #1** - God, help me confront with the goal of \_\_\_\_\_.

**Galatians 6:1a (NIV)** “Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently.”

**James 5:19–20 (NIV)** “My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring that person back, remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins.”

Confrontation without love is harsh. Love without confrontation is \_\_\_\_\_. Restoration requires both.

**Prayer #2** - God, help me confront with \_\_\_\_\_.

**Galatians 6:1b (NIV)** “...But watch yourselves, or you also may be tempted.”

**1 Corinthians 10:12 (NIV)** “So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don’t fall!”

**Prayer #3** - God, help me see when \_\_\_\_\_.

**Psalms 51:10 (NIV)** “Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.”

It always seems easier to wear a mask than to repent. But only \_\_\_\_\_ restores joy.

**TALK IT OVER**

- 1. Heart Check:** Jesus said people can honor God with their lips while their hearts are far from Him. In what ways can this happen in our lives today, and how can we guard against it?
- 2. Loving Confrontation:** Galatians 6:1 calls believers to restore others gently. What does Christlike confrontation look like in practice when we see hypocrisy in someone we care about?
- 3. Personal Reflection:** David realized his own sin when Nathan said, “You are the man.” Why is it often easier to see hypocrisy in others than in ourselves, and how can we invite God to reveal it in our own hearts?
