TRUTH #1 - Christ Is Everything We Need For _____

Colossians 2:9-10a (NIV) “For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, 10 and in Christ you have been brought to fullness.”

TRUTH #2 - Christ Is Everything We Need In _____

Psalm 73:25-26 (NIV) “Whom have I in heaven but you? And earth has nothing I desire besides you. 26 My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.”

TRUTH #3 - Christ Is Everything We Need _____

Revelation 21:22-23 (NIV) “I did not see a temple in the city, because the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. 23 The city does not need the sun or the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and the Lamb is its lamp.”
