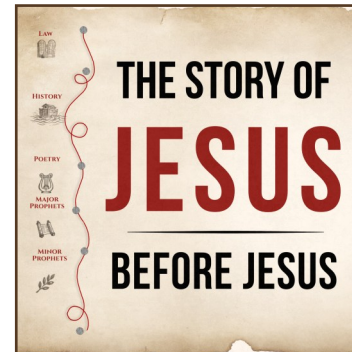

Four Big Themes In The Minor Prophets That Prepared God's People for Jesus.

THEME #1: In Hosea, Joel, & Amos God Promises to _____ His People.

Joel 2:28 (NIV) “And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.”

The Jesus Connection:

Jesus came to _____ our broken relationship with God.

Theme #2: In Obadiah, Jonah, & Micah God Promises a _____ for the Nations.

Micah 5:2 (NIV) “But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times.”

Theme #3: In Nahum, Habakkuk, & Zephaniah God Promises to _____ and Establish Justice.

Habakkuk 2:4b (NIV) “The righteous person will live by his faithfulness.” Rm. 1:17 “The righteous live by faith.”

At the cross and through His resurrection, Jesus defeated sin and death. When He returns—evil will be eradicated, justice will prevail, and God's people will live under the reign of their eternal King.
